He was the oldest of eight children.

He married (1) Matilda COMAN #58266, abt. 1834,⁷ born 10 Apr 1814 in Morrisville, NY,⁷ occupation missionary to China,⁷ died 5 Mar 1835 in Singapore, China,⁷ buried in Section L2, Mt. Hope Cem., Rochester, NY.⁷

He married (2) Theodosia BARKER #58267, abt. 1838,⁷ born 29 Mar 1819 in Thetford, England,⁷ occupation missionary to China 5y,⁷ died 29 Mar 1843 in Hong Kong, China,⁷ buried in Section L2, Mt. Hope Cem., Rochester, NY.⁷

He married (3) Maria MAIN #58268, abt. 1854,⁷ born 3 Oct 1818 in New York City,^{7,8} occupation missionary to Siam 45y,⁷ died 16 Jan 1883 in Boston, Mass.,⁷ buried in Section L2, Mt. Hope Cem., Rochester, NY.⁷

On April 1st 1918 William K. Dean was was taxed for 130 acres and homestead with a value of \$3000, and one cow valued at \$85.00. Total valuation was \$3085 for which he was billed \$82.21. He was taxed for one horse and two cows in 1915.

He married Mary "Polly" Augusta DEAN #17516, 12 Feb 1880 in South Hadley, Mass.,¹⁹ born 11 Jun 1851 in Rochester, New York,^{20,7} (daughter of Henry Walter DEAN #53928 [1818 - 1878] and Elizabeth SMITH #58261 [1820 - 1877]), died 15 Sep 1919 in Jaffrey, NH at home of Rev. F.R. Enslin,^{11,21} (Widowed. Sans posterite. She died on the same date as Rebecca McManes-Colfelt, BK #53918. The Enslin home is located at the NW corner of Oak St. and what was then East Main St.), buried in Section L2, Mt. Hope Cem., Rochester, NY.¹⁸
